












When journey turns unforgettable . . .

Lakshadweep is an archipelago consisting of 27 islands, 12 atolls, 3 reefs and 5 submerged banks in the Arabian Sea. Islands have 32 sq.kms and the lagoons covered by atolls cover an area of 4200 sq.kms. The tiniest Union Territory of India formed in 1956 is tucked away at 220-440 km off the Kerala coast. Kavaratti is the administrative headquarter. All Islands constitute one district for administration with 4 tehsils. Each district has a democratic setup in the form of a village (Dweep) Panchayat. At Union Territory level, there is a District Panchayat. Lakshadweep is the best tropical coral island of India and India's one of its kind "Adventure Sport Nature Tourism" location that owns world's premier dive spots, rich eco-system, marine wealth, coral reefs, silver sandy beaches, virgin environment and pristine water.

The best time to visit Lakshadweep is from October to mid May. From mid May to September, it is roinu.

Here your holidays are filled with the music of silence, strolling down sandy beaches, wandering in the long pathway, indulging in local cuisine and exhilarating water sports. This is absolutely a dream come true moment in one's holiday.

Specialty Islands

ACATTI

459 km away from Kochi. It is 6 km long and 1 km wide. The lagoons have rich coral growths and multi coloured coral fishes. Agattil carries some of the best swimming beaches, unsurpossed diving, snorkeling and fishing spots in the world. Agattil is connected by air from Kochi and is the gateway to uninhabited islands Bangaram and Thinnakara where comfortable tented accommodation is available. Enjoy the abundant coral growths, get involved in water sports like diving and snorkeling, swim doing the best beaches in the world, go for deep sea fishing

BANGARAM

458 km from Kochi, which spreads over 120 acres, it wilnesses warm almate round the year. Bangaram is surrounded by a shallow lagoon enclosed by coral reef. It is ranked among the best get aways of the world. One can discover the graceful fishers, porcupines, parrots, puffer fishes, hermit crobs and sea birds here. There are options for souba diving, beach games, swimming, snorkeling and deep sea fishing. Tented accommodation is available in this island. Dive into the shallow sea to enjoy soubad kings, norkeling and to engage yourself in beaches.

KALPENI

287 km away from Kochi. It has one of the largest lagoons in Lakshadweep archipelago. Here one can swim, reef walk or water sport on kayak, sall boat and pedal boat. Water sport crafts are available on hire. Two bathing huts with change rooms are available at Koomel Beach Resort. A visit to the Hosiery factory and the light house is also included in the day's program. It is a part of Lakshadweep Samudram and Coral Reef package.

KADMAT

407 km away from Kochi. It is 8 km long and 550 m wide at its broadest point and has a very large logoon on the western side with abundant oral growth. Under Marine Wealth Awareness Programme', one can spend 3-4 days here. Kadmat offers long sandy beaches for sunbath and water sports crafts like kayaks, pedal boats, salling yachts, skling boats and glass-bottomed boats are available on hire. Air conditioned and non-air-conditioned accommodation are available in this island. One can visit the island in Coral Reef packages as well as flight packages from Kochi.

KAVARATTI

Kavaratti is the administrative capital of Lakshadweep, It is located between 10° 33° North latitude and 72° 38° East longitude, 4,04 km away from Kochi. Kavaratti is an ideal spot for water sports, swimming and basking on warm sandy beaches. Prime attraction is the capitivating aquarulum with many varieties of corols and different species of beautiful colourful fishes. Planetarium has been opened for tourists and public. Urja Mosque, a most important plajrim centre of Muslims, is situated here. There is a facility for easy leveling of the exotic underwater world through the glass bottomed boats. Kayaks and sailing yachts are available on hire. Lakshadweep Diving Academy is located at Kavaratti. It is part Lakshadweep Samudram, Silver Sands and Coral Reef package.

MINICOY

398 km away from Kochi. It is about 10.6 km long and is the second largest island in the territory. Minicoy is almost completely covered with coconut trees. It is semi-circular shaped and has one of the largest lagoons. Viringili is the small islet that can be seen on the south. Two blocks of tourist cottages are available for the staying tourists. It is part of Lakshadweep Samudram , Coral Reef and Swaying Palm packages Visit the ancient light house constructed in 1885. Get a snack peek into the tuna canning factory, enjoy a long drive through the dense coconut grooves and winding village roads. Options for swimming, beach walk, pedal booting.
